
Directions

From exit 298 of the PA Turnpike, take Route 10 south to the stoplight at Route 322 in Honey Brook. Continue on Route 10 for about 3 miles to Beaver Dam Road. Turn left onto Beaver Dam Road and continue east for about 1.5 miles. Tel Hai Camp will be on your right.

From Route 30, take Route 10 North about 5 miles to Beaver Dam Rd. After turning right (east) onto Beaver Dam Rd continue about 1.5 miles to the camp entrance.

General Information:

- ◆ Sign Up: These are co-ed classes for Home Schoolers. Archery and Canoeing are ages 10 through high school. Maximum class size is 16 for archery and 14 for canoeing.
- ◆ Registration: Deadline is April 4th. Please fill out and send in the enclosed form.
- ◆ Fee: Each course costs \$50.00 per child for entire course. Fee is due with your registration.
- ◆Upon confirmation of registration: you will receive an information letter as well as a health form which you will need to complete, sign, and return. One is also available on our website. You will receive more detailed course information on the first day.
- ♦ Certificate of Completion: Upon the successful completion of the course, which includes faithful attendance and evidence of growth in skills, participants will receive a certificate of completion.

♦ All equipment provided:

- ♦ Archery: Students may use their own equipment if desired after it is inspected by the instructor. No bows over 30 lbs draws will be allowed.
- ♦ Canoeing: Students may use their own life jacket if desired after it is inspected by the instructor.

Archery Class

- ◆ Class Instruction: The primary objective for this course is to teach level one archery skills, including safety, terminology, scoring, and proper form and techniques. Each weekly session will include warm ups, instruction and practice time, as well as evaluation of skills.
- ◆Bruce Gregory, Instructor: Bruce Gregory, Program Director of Tel Hai Camp & Retreat, has been trained according to NAA instruction. He has been instructing archery since 1983, both teaching campers and training staff.
- ◆ Intermediate Class:
 This class is for those students who have completed the level one class last year, demonstrated above average skills, and wish to move on to the next level. Call Bruce Gregory for acceptance in this class.
